Genesee County Survey WNY STAMP Related Results

The study of 400 registered voters was conducted October 3-5, 2013. All respondents were part of a fully representative sample of registered voters in Genesee County.

The confidence interval associated with a sample of this size is such that:

95% of the time, results from 400 interviews (registered voters) will be within +-5% of the True Values, which refers to the results obtained if it were possible to interview every registered voter in Genesee County.

Below are the responses for questions 10-12 that pertain specifically to the WNY STAMP project in Alabama, NY.



Only 28% are aware and favorable of STAMP, while 56% are unaware.


Aware and Opinion of STAMP?



- -TV news source voters have the highest percentage of unawareness of the STAMP project (75%).
- -Internet news source voters are highly unaware of the STAMP project as well (59%).
- -Un-favorability is very low, as voters who were not aware did not indicate they were unfavorable.

The proposed Science Technology and Advanced Manufacturing Park, called STAMP would be built on a 1250 acre site and have the potential to employ 10,000 good paying technology, manufacturing and support jobs.
